Palm Crosses, Ash Wednesday and Lent: Next Wednesday is Ash Wednesday, the first day of Lent and a day of fasting and abstinence. Palm Crosses that are received by lunchtime on Tuesday will be burned to provide the ashes that will be received on Wednesday. Please note the times of Masses. During Lent we are asked to draw closer to Our Lord and to apply ourselves to work of mercy, repentance and devotion.
