Thanks: Everyone was very sad that **Stella Griffith** was not well enough to join us last week to celebrate her 90th birthday. She has written to express her thanks for all the good wishes, and assures us of her prayers.

Changes in Times of Masses: Copies of the Archbishop's letter are available in all our Churches, confirming that the Mass times in our Parish will be varied, to take effect from Sunday, April 15th, the Sunday after Easter. It is understood that not everyone will be pleased but I hope that everyone will work together to ensure a smooth transition. I hope to meet soon with Barry McFarland so that we can ensure that the present level of Home Communions can be maintained. We shall also be meeting with Altar Servers and Musicians. These changes have been made after much consideration, and we hope that there will be no other disruption to the life of the Communities centred on each of our three Churches. Thanks to everyone who contributed to the period of consultation.
