<u>LENT 2017</u>: The Season of Lent begins on Wednesday, March 1st. We offer a small booklet on **The Meaning of Lent** and it is highly recommended. Please make a donation of £1 per copy. Between now and Shrove Tuesday, please bring last year's palms and place them in the incinerator near the Baptismal font. They will be burned on Shrove Tuesday evening to provide **Ash** for the following day. Stations of the Cross during Lent will be at 11 a.m. each Friday in Tenbury and 7.30 p.m. in Kidderminster (except March 3rd). Please note that Ash Wednesday is a penitential day and we should observe fasting and abstinence. Ashes will be blessed and imposed at all Masses: 9.30 am/7.30 pm in Kidderminster, 11.30 am in Tenbury. Compline will be at 9 pm, and ashes will be given afterwards.

BAPTISM: Today, the Revd. Adam Nicholls will baptise Isaac Jones-Reynolds. This will be the last baptism in the Parish until the Easter Vigil. According to the customary practice, Baptisms do not take place during Lent. For those preparing to enter Full Communion with the Catholic Church, Lent is a time of Spiritual preparation and intense prayer.
