Thank you to those members who have paid their 2017 subscriptions and for the new members that have joined. There are still plenty of numbers available. The next draw will take place at Tenbury after Mass on Sunday 28<sup>th</sup> May. To clarify what appears to be a grey area, the 200 Club rules are that only fully paid up members (£24 per annum) are eligible to be entered in the Christmas draw. We appreciate that we have taken on the 200 Club part way through the year.
