Mass will be said for the intentions of all.

Confirmation: The final meeting of confirmandi, parents, catechists, teachers and clergy will be in the School Hall on Wednesday at 6:30 pm. **Montini Group:** The Montini Group will return to the Church on Tuesday evening at 7:45 pm and our theme will be the **tabernacle**, a consideration of the reserved presence of Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament, and of the place of Exposition, Adoration and Benediction. Everyone very welcome.

Commissioning of the Parish Choir: The Parish wishes to congratulate the members of the choir who are commissioned at Masses today to serve the Parish for the forthcoming year. A warm welcome is also extended to those who have joined in the last year. With confident voice, may they diligently proclaim the message of God, through music and lead us in prayer throughout the new liturgical year.

Choir Practices: will take place on Monday 27th November (7:15pm), Saturday 9th December (10:15pm), and Monday 11th December (7:15pm). **The Craft Club:** will meet in the Parish Hall on Tuesday at 7:30 pm. All welcome.

Catholic Men's Society: The Kidderminster Branch of the Catholic Men's Society will meet in the Wheatley Room on Wednesday at 7:30 pm. **Advice:** Some far reaching plans were discussed at the Deanery Meeting on Tuesday - to try to reduce the workload for some parishes where the priest is currently in poor health, and where a priest is being withdrawn and not replaced. One suggestion is that, in one of our Wyre Forest Parishes, there should be a Mass on Saturdays at 12.30 pm or thereabouts, which would fulfil the Sunday obligation. This could possibly reduce the burden on Sundays and could lead to greater flexibility of Mass times and free someone to help elsewhere if necessary. I would be pleased to hear the views of parishioners. This arrangement works well in some city parishes (e.g. Birmingham, Solihull) but we are not sure what support there would be in an area like the Wyre Forest.

2018: There are three major events taking place in 2018. In the Universal Church there is a **World Meeting** of **Families** to take place in Ireland August $21^{st} - 26^{th}$, at the special request of Pope Francis. In this country there will be **Adoremus**: Eucharistic Pilgrimage and Congress in Liverpool (September $7^{th} - 9^{th}$). In our own Parish it will be the 160^{th} anniversary of the building of our beautiful Parish Church. To prepare for the first two events, there will be a **Eucharist** and **The Family Day** at St George's Worcester on January 20^{th} 10 am - 3.30 pm. Details are on the notice board. I would like us to be represented so that some ideas can be brought back for the benefit of the Parish. Anyone interested is asked to notify Fr. Lamb as soon as possible.

Candlelit Carol Service: The carol service will take place on Monday, 18th December at 7:30pm. This year we are hoping to fully illuminate our beautiful church by candlelight. For this we will need safe places for the candles, such as large jars or similar. If you have anything in your cupboards at home that we may use, please bring in these items and we will collect them by the door to the choir loft.

Her Majesty's Government: is making a critical decision on whether to overturn the admissions cap which prevents Catholic Schools from allowing all Catholic pupils to attend. They have acknowledged this policy discriminates against Catholics and have promised to abandon it. Now we need to tell them not to 'u-turn' on their promise to Catholics. Do you support Catholic Schools and the right of Catholics to send their children to them? Then we need you to make your voice heard. Visit www.catholicnews.org.uk/education-cap and write to the government urging them to drop the policy which bans new Catholic Schools.

World Meeting of Families: The Pope has called for a World Meeting of Families to be held in Ireland in August 2018. He is expected to attend for all, or part of the event. After discussion with our Head Mistress, Mrs. Brocklesby, we are seeking to initiate a year long visitation of all the families associated with our school. The Deacons and I will be helped by a team of parishioners. A planning meeting is to be held early in December and we hope to finish by the Solenmity of Christ the King 2018. Further information will be given after the meeting but at this stage we ask parishioners to pray to the Holy Family for the success of this initiative.

Friends of the Holy Land: will be selling Christmas Cards, olive wood goods, soaps and goods made by the people at the School of Joy following both our Sunday Masses this week. Please come and support us in helping keep our fellow Christians in the land of Our Lord's birth.

Pilgrimage to Lourdes: A pilgrimage to Lourdes under the aegis of the Order of Malta, taking a group of sick, disabled and elderly pilgrims to the shrine, departing from Stansted airport will take place between May 4th-May 10th 2018. Pilgrims are asked to make a contribution of £290 towards the cost of some £600.
