As always, so many people work hard together to ensure that we can offer a worthy celebration of Our Lord's Resurrection. I thank the Ladies of the UCM and the Cunliffe family for their organisation and participation in our very moving commemoration of the Passover. Also it is good to thank those who have cleaned the Church, prepared the flowers and participated as Servers, Readers and in their ministries. Thanks to Alison McCormack and her parents for laundering our servers' vestments. This year I would like to make special mention of the Musicians and Choir, and our Sacristan. The Choir has spent a long time during Lent practising for our Liturgies of the Triduum, and I know their efforts are appreciated by very many of our parishioners. At the Chrism Mass in the Cathedral the presentation of the music **exactly mirrored** what has become the norm in our Parish, evidence that our music accords with the mind of the Church. We now have a proper balance of traditional plainchant (the music of the Church) in Latin (the language of the Church) with good quality vernacular hymns and Mass settings. It is particularly pleasing that we now sing the INTROIT and the COMMUNION VERSE as the Liturgy intends. There are **appropriate** items for the Choir to sing, including the Responsorial Psalm on occasions. Now that this tradition is established it is my wish and intention that it should continue. The Choir and I hope that the standard of congregational singing will be enhanced over the coming months.

No praise is too lavish for the efforts of Jean Bullock, our Sacristan, during the days leading up to Easter. She spent long hours in the cold Church, with meticulous attention to details; everything for the altar and ceremonies was in pristine condition and, as always, was immediately to hand. Hers is very much a hidden rôle, as she prefers, but one that is absolutely indispensible.
