Parish Finances: Many people in the Parish are now aware of the new Diocesan implementation of Parish levies. The Finance Committee will be calling a Parish Meeting in the next few weeks to discuss the current state of our Parish finances. We have been running at a loss for some years now, only managed by having reserves from a generous bequest and the proceeds of the sale of Habberley. These funds are finite. This year the Diocese has increased the levy on Parishes by 84%. Substantial savings will need to be made. At my request all areas of current expenditure will be seriously examined in order to establish whether present arrangements can be sustained.

**Confirmation:** Fr Lamb has received special delegation to confirm RAFAL WOJCIECH DEC during Mass this morning. Rafal is to be a Confirmation Sponsor in Poland early in February, and was unable to be part of our Parish Confirmation in December. Please pray for him as he receives this important Sacrament today.
