A Reflection for Lent: Many years ago, Fr Dominic Johnson, a monk at Glenstal Abbey reminded me that, if we perform the Liturgy as well as possible with the resources available, all else in the Parish will fall into place. This became obvious to me last Sunday when the tone of the Liturgy changed, and assumed the starkness which the Church clearly wishes us to have during the Lent Season. Occasionally comments are heard about the length of our Sunday Mass, the extent of our music provision and the amount of ceremonial we have. When I attended the AGM of the Union of Catholic Mothers; when I hear from parents about the good things going on in our School; when I see the range of activities and opportunities we provide within our Parish Community; and when the goodness of so many of our parishioners is so obvious, I am more than ever aware of the wisdom of Fr Dominic's words. A good undertaking for Lent would be to resolve, all of us, to play our own unique and significant part in our Parish life.
