# \*IMPORTANT NOTICE\*: CORVID-19 [CORONAVIRUS]

We have been advised by the Bishop's Conference of England & Wales that the following measures now apply:

- 1. Holy Communion will NOT be received from the Chalice until further notice
- 2. Holy Communion should **NOT** be received on the tongue. Ministers should, as far as possible, **avoid physical contact** with Communicants
- 3. The Sign of Peace will NOT be given
- 4. Holy Water stoups at the Church doors are to be emptied
- 5. The Collection baskets will not be passed around the Congregation. They will be offered by the Collectors
- 6. Those with cold or flu symptoms should **avoid being present** at Parish gatherings
- 7. We are asked to **suspend hospitality after Masses**, where multiple people touch cups, mugs, utensils, biscuits etc.
- 8. We are, at present, unable to provide sanitized gel dispensers, so we ask that those who have these products are sure to use them; that everyone, particularly Ministers of Holy Communion, are especially attentive to matters of hand hygiene. There are facilities in the Parish Hall and, if necessary, in the Rectory, prior to Masses
