Beatification of Pope Paul VI: Today in Rome, Pope Paul VI has been declared 'Blessed'. He was elected Pope in 1963 and brought the Second Vatican Council to a conclusion. He died in 1978. In the years before his Pontificate, he was a successor of St Ambrose, and St Charles Borromeo as Archbishop of Milan. We have installed a small picture of him beneath the memorial window for Canon Charles Ambrose Wheatley, and **Fr. Julian Booth** will preach on the legacy of Pope Paul during the 6.00pm Mass. Pope Paul will be another Patron for us in Heaven, and it is legitimate now for us to seek his intercession. After Mass, please join a little celebration in the Adams Lounge, to meet Fr. Booth and to honour the new Beatus.
